In one of her first film jobs, Steven Spielberg's HOOK, she was cast to do all three. Legendary composer John Williams conducted her into his score. It was during that session, in the very same soundstage that Judy Garland laid down the tracks to Somewhere Over the Rainbow, that she knew she was "hooked." Singing would have to be a part of her path.

She has sung jazz in Los Angeles, New Orleans and New York City.

She has been lucky enough to share songs on the bandstand with: Bob Draga, John Reynolds, Dan Levinson, Chris Dawson, Dean Moira, Katie Cavera, Ben Polcer, Benedikt Brydern and Tom Fischer. She is a present day Red Hot Mama. This isn't a persona she puts on she just is a feisty talent who swings hard and can also remind you what a real ballad feels like.

As Bessie Smith crooned "A Good Man Is Hard to Find" but good music isn't it's right here, alive and well and you have found it. Vibrant and ready to excite a whole new batch of hipsters!
